Chair Allie Pesch called the meeting to order at 7:01

The members of the Committee introduced themselves.

Economic Development Presentation and Discussion:

Roger Johnson, the Director of Economic Development for the County introduced himself and J.T. Newberry, the Economic Development Coordinator

Roger also introduced Rebecca Haydock from the Central Virginia Small Business Development Center (CVSBDC)

- Rebecca provided a short presentation about the CVSBDC, and the services that it can provide to existing and planned businesses, most of which are free of charge.
- The CVSBDC is supported by the U.S. Small Business Administration and the Virginia Small Business Development Center

There was a brief discussion about how the CVSBDC can assist local businesses, such as the following:

- Free, confidential guidance from numerous subject matter experts on staff (marketing, website design, business plan development, access to capital, e-commerce, and strategic plans, among many others)

- Industry circles to support members in certain industries and provide opportunities for collaboration
- Innovation commercialization program -- helps those with new business ideas refine their plan

Roger then provided a presentation on the County's Economic Development Strategy:

- It started with a video "The Flow of Money" describing the difference between consumptive businesses and primary businesses and how primary businesses can help provide more revenue for our local economy
- Discussion of the Economic Development Department's macro-level approach to economic development

Additional Presentation Topics:

- How the EDD assisted local businesses during the pandemic (microloans and grants)
- Buy Local campaign
- Project ENABLE (Enabling a Better Life Economically) the County's Economic Development Strategic Plan
- Discussion of how the Crozet Community can enhance the local economy, and the challenges and opportunities for economic development in Crozet

Additional Discussion Topics:

- The experience of other Crozet businesses with the Economic Development Department
- The role of the Arts in economic development

Committee Business:

Once a quorum was achieved, the minutes from the November meeting were approved by unanimous vote following a motion to approve by Brian Day and a second by Sandra Hausman.

There was a discussion about potential openings on the Committee following several recent resignations, and timing for new appointments.
